



DUTY TO WARN

When a person receiving services, a member of their immediate family or any other credible person communicates to an employee a threat of violence against a reasonably identifiable victim or victims you must contact a member of management immediately and inform them of what has been communicated so that action is taken to protect the potential victim or victims.

All LADD employees are responsible for taking action to warn and protect reasonably identifiable victims when a threat of harm is made using the steps outlined in the Duty to Warn Policy.
