In pursuit of this endeavor, the following Exposure Control Plan (ECP) is provided to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens in accordance with MIOSHA Part 554 Bloodborne Infectious Diseases and OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens standard, 29 CFR 1910.1030

The ECP is a key document to assist our company in implementing and ensuring compliance with the standard, thereby protecting our employees. This ECP includes:

- Determination of employee exposure;
- Implementation of various methods of exposure control, including:
 - Universal precautions;
 - Engineering and work practice controls;
 - Standard operating procedures;
 - Personal protective equipment; and,
 - Housekeeping;
- Hepatitis B vaccination;
- Post-exposure evaluation and follow-up;
- Communication of hazards to employees and training;
- Recordkeeping; and,
- Procedures for evaluating circumstances surrounding an exposure incident
