



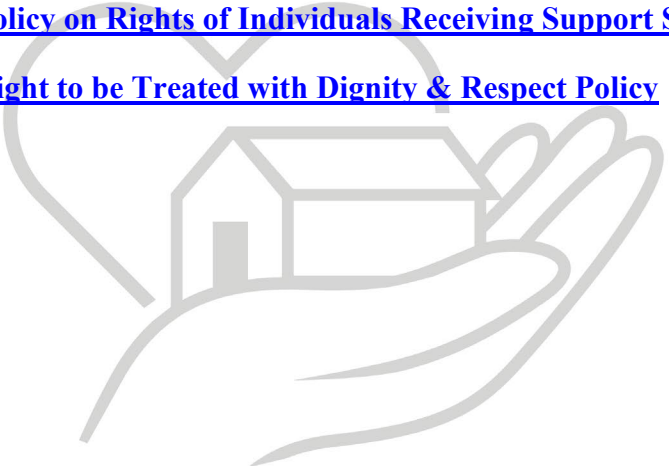
8.3 RIGHTS OF THE INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING SUPPORT SERVICES

RECIPIENT RIGHTS

Employees of LADD are required by their job as well as the law to ensure the rights and safety of the people supported are maintained at all times as well as report any time their rights have been violated. In addition to the rights, benefits, and privileges guaranteed by other provisions of the law, the state constitution of 1963 and the constitution of the United States a recipient of mental health services shall have the rights guaranteed by the Michigan Mental Health Code unless otherwise restricted by law.
